The following prices are the maximum indicative prices for Petrol, Diesel and Kerosene to apply at service stations (including GST) at the centres identified. These prices will take effect from 12:01am on Saturday, 8th May, 2021, and reflect the Import Parity Prices (IPP) that will apply for the month until the next price change.
